NBDA Directors,

This Saturday, November 9<sup>th</sup>, the HS All-District and first-round All-State auditions will be held at Broken Arrow Senior High School which is located at 1901 E. Albany in Broken Arrow. I have attached a map of the campus to assist with parking and locating each building.

We will have a short directors meeting at 8:15am in the Media Center just inside the main entrance under the big clock tower (see map for "Main 860"). Because we're using G-Toms, there will be no live draw. Instead, the times have been randomly pre-determined by the program. Students must come to their room at 8:30am to sign in and to see their approximate audition time and order. **Auditions will begin at 9:00am.** Though students will have an approximate time, they should monitor the room throughout the day.

I will send the most recent version of the judging assignment to everyone tomorrow as a reminder of what James Morrison has already sent the membership. Given the added responsibilities, it is imperative that **everyone** be in attendance for our students. Breakfast snacks and lunch will be provided for all directors in the media center.

Warm up and Concessions will be in the Cafeteria Building, Southeast of the Main Building, Building B, and the Visual Performing Arts Center (see map). The Cafeteria Building is large enough for percussion equipment to roll in should you wish.

Please note that scales ARE NOT being played at this audition (major OR chromatic).

Students should find their rooms as soon as they arrive at the school. Cuts and scales will be posted at each room by 8AM. **It is very important that students sign in at their room before the audition.** Rooms that have multiple instruments will audition in the order listed (E-flat Clarinet/B-flat Clarinet...Oboe/Bassoon/Bass Clarinet/...Tenor Sax/Bari Sax). Results will be posted in the main lobby of the school on the trophy cases outside the Media Center and 2<sup>nd</sup> Round Audition Material will be available in the Media Center.

Once results have been posted, folders will be laid out by school in the media center. Please pick up all folders before you leave for the day. I hope this letter answers any questions you may have and I look forward to seeing you on Saturday.
